GUIDELINES FOR TAKING ROUTINE INSPECTION PICTURES IN EMARG





Do not click pictures in the dark or low lighting conditions.

X Don't



Ensure that the pictures are clicked in landscape mode. Take extra caution not to flip or rotate the pictures.

X Don't



Do not click pictures from inside a vehicle or when on it, as it might subject them to blurring, glare etc.

X Don't



Pictures should not be blurred, have glares due to the sun or other camera related defects.

Don't



Do not click pictures with vehicles, pedestrians, animals or other objects on the road so as to not hide any part of the road.

GUIDELINES FOR TAKING ROUTINE INSPECTION PICTURES IN eMARG





Do not click pictures of milestones, sign boards etc. Make sure that the surface of the road is the primary focus of the picture.





Do not take pictures from the side of the road. Ensure that you capture as much of the road ahead of you and not to your side.



Example of a properly clicked picture



- ☑ Clicked in proper daylight
- ✓ Clicked in landscape mode
- ☑ Clicked standing on the road and not from a vehicle
- ✓ Is not blurred or have glares
- ✓ No vehicles or other objects on road
- ✓ Taken from the middle of the road and not from the side.
